


COMMUNITY WATCH

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETINGS

The board's last meeting of January 27, 2016 was conducted at the WGFD Headquarters. Larry Blair updated the board as to the treasurer's report; upcoming bills are for the landscaping, general and professional insurance and postage for mailings. The board unanimously agreed to change our banking from Wells Fargo to Fairwinds Credit Union due to no monthly fees. This will save in our 2016 budget. Mike and Larry will be making arrangements in the upcoming week to get all transferred. Past due accounts were discussed and those homeowners will receive notification as to those outstanding dues. A reserve in the amount of \$2,400 has been set aside as our yearly contingency for any emergencies that may arise. Electricity and water for the front entrance has

been approved by the board to be turned back on in the upcoming months. Until such time, our President, Mike Caines has been so kind to have the lights plugged in from his property. With the Spring time coming, the board has approved up to a \$500 for new plants and mulch in and around the front entrance. We will work in phases with the landscaping to refresh. The board has sent a letter to Lake Cove Pointe HOA with regard to the landscaping in the island on S. Timbercreek. We are still hopeful since this is their entry way as well, they will split the costs to refresh this area's curb appeal.
